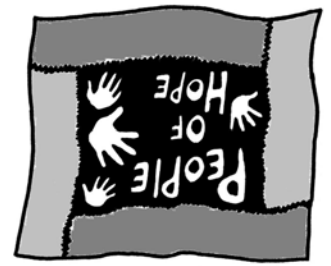
Go north on North Avenue past the perimeter (loop 10), turn left on Sunny Hills Drive and right on Freeman Drive.

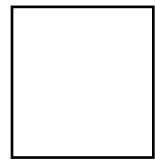
